SPORT HORSE CLASS LIST

Dressage Breeding Division–Mature Horse

1. Broodmare, 4 years & older with or without foal, mare only judged
2. Maiden/Yeld Mares, 4 years & older
3. *Mare Championship—open to 1st and 2nd place from 1 & 2
4. Stallions—4 years & older, not currently standing @ stud
5. Stallions—4 years & older, currently standing @ stud
6. *Stallion Championship—open to 1st and 2nd place from 4 & 5
7. Mature Horse Championship—open to Champion and Reserve from 3 & 6

Sport Horse Prospect Division–Young Horse

8. Fillies–3 year old (2005)
9. Fillies–2 year old (2006)
10. Fillies–yearling (2007)
11. Fillies of 2008–w/wo Dam
12. *Filly Championship–open to 1st and 2nd place from 8–11
13. Colts/Geldings–3 year old (2005)
14. Colts/Geldings–2 year old (2006)
15. Colts/Geldings–yearling (2007)
16. Colts/Geldings of 2008–w/wo Dam
17. *Colts/Geldings Championship–open to 1st and 2nd place from 13–16

19. Grand Champion–open to Champion and Reserve from 7 & 18

Group Class

20. Produce of Dam–2 or 3 offspring w/wo dam
21. Get of Sire–without sire, 2 or 3 of get
22. **Breeder's Group**–Group of two or three horses of any age or sex, all bred by the same exhibitor, and all must have shown in one in-hand class.
Amateur Handler–To be shown in-hand by an Amateur or Jr/YR with a current USEF Amateur card. Open to fillies/mares and geldings in any age group. No Stallions or Colts except weanlings. To be judged on presentation of the animal to the judge, neatness and appearance of the handler, overall condition of the animal, handling techniques, appropriate tack and equipment, demonstration of correct training and ability to show horse to the best of its ability.
23. **Amateur Handler**–Class will be divided as JR and AA if entries warrant.
Materiale Classes–Horses will be evaluated under saddle at W/T/C, then will be required to remove tack and will be judged on confirmation according to the criteria listed on the “USDF Dressage Sport Horses Prospects Under Saddle” individual score sheets. Ages maybe combined if entries warrant.
24. Fillies–3 year old
25. Colts/Geldings–3 year old
26. Mares–4 & 5 year old
27. Colts/Geldings–4 & 5 year old
Under Saddle Classes–For classes 28 thru 32, entries shall be shown at the walk/trot/canter both ways of the ring. Judging to be weighted 60% Movement, 30% Confirmation, 10% General impression.
28. Fillies–3 years old (2005)
29. Colts/Geldings–3 years old (2005)
30. Mares–4 year & older
31. Stallion/Gelding–4 year & older
32. Suitable to become a Dressage Horse–Entries must be at least 36 mos and no more than 7 years old, and cannot have competed above First Level.
33. Under Saddle Championship–open to 1st and 2nd place from 28 thru 32

1. AWARDS

All 1st place will receive a trophy. Six ribbons will be presented in each class except in championship classes, which will be awarded Champion & Reserve.

2. ENTRIES

- a) In-Hand & Under Saddle classes—\$40. Group Class—\$30/horse. No fee for Sport Horse Championship class. Please specify Performance or Sport Horse on class entry.
- b) A \$12 drug fee (\$7 Drug&Med fee, \$5 USEF fee), a non-refundable \$15 office fee, a negative Coggins dated within 12 months of show date; and all entries MUST submit USEF and USDF documents for rider, owner, trainer and horse as appropriate for entry/classes. Please include \$20 USEF non-member fee and/or \$5 discipline fee if applicable for non-Jrs.
- c) Make checks payable to TEN BROECK FARM
- d) No refunds after closing date.
- e) Non-negotiable check will be charged \$25.
- f) Refunds will be given for cancellations received in writing, email, or fax before the closing date less \$15 office fee.
- g) Post entries will be accepted to fill scratches with a \$20 post entry fee.

3. TIMES

4. STABLING

Limited number of temporary stalls with full doors available at \$145 for duration. A stall cleaning deposit of \$25 on a separate check is required. Tack stalls available only if space permits. No refunds on stabling after closing date (except for stall deposit). May arrive on Thursday afternoon, must vacate by 7pm Sunday.
