22. Breeder's Group—Group of two or three horses of any age or sex, all bred by the same exhibitor, and all must have shown in one in-hand class.

Amateur Handler—To be shown in-hand by an Amateur or Jr/YR with a current USEF Amateur card. Open to fillies/mares and geldings in any age group. No Stallions or colts except weanlings. To be judged on presentation of the animal to the judge, neatness and appearance of the handler, overall condition of the animal, handling techniques, appropriate tack and equipment, demonstration of correct training and ability to show horse to the best of its ability.

23. Amateur Handler—Class will be divided as JR and AA if entries warrant.

Materiale Classes—Horses will be evaluated under saddle at W/T/C, then will be required to remove tack and will be judged on confirmation according to the criteria listed on the "USDF Dressage Sport Horses Prospects Under Saddle" individual score sheets. Ages may be combined if entries warrant.

Under Saddle Classes—For classes 28 thru 32, entries shall be shown at the walk/trot/canter both ways of the ring. Judging to be weighted 60% Movement, 30% Confirmation, 10% General impression.

PLEASE NOTE : This a 2 Show / 2 Day Weekend, each show needs to be handled with a separate entry & check—incomplete entries will have a \$ 10 Office Charge added.

New England Breed Show Series Sweepstakes and \$2100 NEDA Fall Show Purse

Entry into the Sweepstake is \$50/horse per qualifying Breed Show. The top score from the primary in hand age group USDF class for the horse (foal, yearlings, 2 year old, 3 year old, mares, stallions) only will count towards the award. Only 1 score per show per horse qualifies. The top 6 scoring horses of the qualifying show will get the Sweepstakes cash award. Minimum award for 1st place \$50-100 depending upon entries and class sponsors. Entries have to be in by the shows closing date. No exceptions. Awards are based on entries at the closing and can not be changed. If there is less than 6 entries, only the number of entries will be awarded.

Each horse that enters and competes at a sweepstakes at a qualifying New England Breed show automatically qualifies for the NEDA Fall Breed Show Sweepstakes for free. No Sweepstakes fee is charged at the NEDA Fall Show, but the class entry fee is still required. The qualifying horse must enter and compete in the NEDA Fall Breed Show primary age group class (foal, yearling, 2 year old, 3 year old, mares, stallions) to receive the Sweepstakes prize for that show. NEDA will provide a cash award to the top 6 “colts” and top 6 “fillies” at the NEDA Fall Show. 1st place \$300, 2nd \$250, 3rd \$200, 4th \$150, 5th, \$100, 6th \$50.

1. AWARDS

All 1st place will receive a trophy. Six ribbons will be presented in each class except in championship classes, which will be awarded Champion & Reserve.

2. ENTRIES

- a) In-Hand & Under Saddle classes—\$45. Group Class—\$35/horse. No fee for Sport Horse Championship class. Please specify Performance or Sport Horse on class entry.
- b) A \$15 drug fee (\$7 Drug&Med fee, \$9 USEF fee), a non-refundable \$15 office fee, a negative Coggins dated within 12 months of show date; and all entries MUST submit USEF and USDF documents for rider, owner, trainer and horse as appropriate for entry/classes. Please include \$20 USEF non-member fee and/or \$5 discipline fee if applicable for non-Jrs.
